PARK STEWARDSHIP INTERN – SPRING 2019

Status:	Intern/seasonal

Position Duration:	20 hrs./week - 14 weeks

Classification:	Regular - Employee does not routinely have supervision responsibilities.

The position of **Park Stewardship Intern** directly involves but is not limited to the following illustrative duties:

1. Assists the stewardship department with land management projects, stewardship programs, and special events. Must be able to work well with groups of all ages and abilities.
2. Assists with the collection, cleaning, propagation, and planting of native seed species.
3. May be required to operate a variety of equipment, including but not limited to the following; power tools such as saws, drills, and weed eaters.
4. Assists park visitors and volunteers when needed. Must be courteous and helpful at all times.
5. Works flexible hours including occasional evenings, weekends, and holidays when necessary. Must be able to meet the position duration listed above.
6. Must be able to routinely lift 80 pounds.
7. Performs other duties as assigned by the Stewardship Coordinator that are deemed appropriate and necessary for the position.

Requirements:

Preferred qualifications include a high school diploma or G.E.D. Must possess a valid driver's license.

Recommended:

- Enrolled in a college program, such as biology environmental science, urban agriculture, or related field.
- Prior knowledge of ecosystems and plant species is helpful, but not required.
