

Facility Rental COVID-19 Supplemental Agreement

Renter is aware that the following safety precautions can help slow the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19). Renter agrees to comply with the following safety precautions and urge guests to do the same:

- We agree to practice social distancing by maintaining a 6-foot distance between persons to the fullest extent possible while in the facility, on the porch/deck areas, and while on the grounds.
- We understand that face coverings are required, except when actively eating or drinking.
- We agree to keep tables at least 6 feet apart. Tables and chairs have been prearranged with social distancing in mind. We agree to not move the tables for seating or add tables and chairs. Tables and chairs are set at the maximum capacity for the facility (60 people).
- We understand that family members from the same household should share a table to the fullest extent possible.
- We agree to not use self-service food stations. Food must be served by a person or persons while wearing a face covering and gloves. Food shall be served only when all participants are seated.
- We agree to encourage guests to wash hands often. We understand that we are to supply hand sanitizer for use by our group.
- It is understood that no one is permitted to enter the facility if symptomatic. Per the CDC, symptoms include cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, chills, muscle pain, sore throat and new loss of taste or smell.
- We agree to clean high-contact surfaces hourly. Proper cleaning supplies will be supplied by the Park District for your use.
- We understand that dance floors and congregating areas are not permitted. All guests must remain seated during event.
- Failure to comply with these guidelines will result in the immediate termination of your event, forfeiture of your deposit and may result in being banned from future rentals of Park District facilities.

Renter assumes the risk associated with a social gathering at a Wood County Park District Facility and agrees to waive all claims or causes of action arising from the use of the facility and agrees to release the Wood County Park District and its agents, employees, and volunteers and their heirs, executors, and assigns from liability.
