



Register your group to decorate and light-up one of ten stations at the **Wild-Lights Workshop, January 5th (weather date January 6th)**. The "most inspired" stations will be awarded **\$25, \$50, or \$100** (courtesy of the Friends of the Wood County Park District)! Bring festive cheer to life-sized 3D animal statues and turn the woods at W.W. Knight Nature Preserve into a magical twinkling forest for visitors to explore during the **Wild Lights Weekend, January 7-9, 2022**.

Rules for participation:

1. What You're Decorating: Stations may be comprised of 1 to 3 animal statues. Your station will be chosen at random. At the workshop, stations will be outdoors and 40'-80' apart from each other. Look forward to an email with extra instructions, a picture of your station, and map by January 3, 2022.

2. Power and Lighting: Supply your own lights. Only LED lights will be allowed to avoid exceeding the capabilities of our generators. 1 extension cord will be fed to your station - participants are responsible for supplying outdoor-rated splitters and extra extension cords as needed according to your decoration needs.

3. Decorations: No political, scary, obscene, or otherwise inappropriate decorations or themes. No fire, sharp-objects, inflatables, moving or animatronic or otherwise dangerous decorations. No synthetic tinsel. Wild-Lights Weekend event is designed for families and children.

4. Placement: Decorations and lights may be placed no more than 10' from any part of the 3D animal statue you are assigned. Your centerpiece should be the 3D animal statues. 3D animal statues are made of heavy foam; use long tacks, nails, or tape to affix lights and decorations.

5. Disclaimer: Decorations may be subject to adverse weather, wildlife, public tampering, or other means of damage, loss, or destruction. Decorations will not be supervised at all times. Participants agree to hold harmless the Wood County Park District for any and all instances of property damage or loss as it relates to this program.

6. Retrieval of decorations will start Monday January 10, 2022; Deadline for pickup Sunday January 16, 2022.

Stations will be judged by a panel of Wood County Parks staff and volunteer judges. Winners will be determined Sunday, January 9, 2022. All participants will be contacted directly and a public announcement made.
